**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF THE COCKER SPANIEL CLUB FIELD TRIAL SECTION will be held on Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2026 at 1.00pm at Haddenham Village Hall, Banks Park, Haddenham, Bucks. HP17 8EE.**

The Village of Haddenham is situated off the A418 between Oxford and Aylesbury. Turn off the M40 at J 8A and take the A 418 towards Thame and Aylesbury. After passing Thame turn right towards Haddenham into Thame Rd. Continue along Thame Rd to Haddenham village centre, pass the Rising Sun pub on your right, follow the road past the shops, turn right at the small roundabout, the village hall is immediately on the right. You need to park in the marked bays and register your registration number on the tablet at the entrance to the room or risk a ticket. The 2hr limit is lifted when you register your number.
