1st. Torbett's Kirlinjis Fast'n'Furious.

Very promising 11 months blue. Well moulded head, good eye & expression, correct neck, lay of shoulder & upper arm. Quality & substance in bone. Strong ribcage, short back & compact loin giving typical cobby appearance. Well made hindquarters.

Sound & free in movement.

2nd. Czipott's I Will Be Famous Wizard.

Another promising 10 months blue. Attractive head, sweet eye & expression. Well made forehand & legs. Strong loin & coupling. Good turn of hindquarters. Needs a little more confidence to make the most of his qualities. Scored in spring of rib & head planes.

3rd. Bayliss's Wilanorah We Will Rock You.

PARTICOLOUR NOVICE DOG (6,1).

1st. Craig's Alisma Amarillio.

13 months blue. Balanced skull & muzzle, good eye colour & expression. Excellent head carriage, well laid shoulders, legs & feet. Big ribs, short back & strong loin. Well turned hindquarters with correct set on of tail. Sound & free on the move.

2nd. Handl & Eisen's Haradwater Mr. Fantastic.

18 months B/W. Good head properties, dark, expressive eye, low ears. Good head carriage, neck & forehand, legs & feet. Ribcage still developing, compact loin & coupling. Well turned hindquarters. Happy character. Scored in neck & shoulders.

3rd. Beswick's Esqueen's Give A Gift For Cashel.

PARTICOLOUR GRADUATE DOG (6,0)

1st. Morris's Riondel Enigma.

Attractive light blue. Has quality & substance throughout. Good muzzle, stop and skull. Dark, well set eye and kind expression. Pleasing head carriage, neck & shoulder. Shapely bone & feet. Well sprung ribs, strong loin & coupling. Strong stifles & hocks. Moved well.

2nd. Marris Bray, Wiggins & Woods' Glowhill Gallivant.

Blue with good over all outline. Clean skull, dark eye. Well made forehand, legs & feet. Good spring of rib, short coupled with well

set on tail. Good gait in profile, on which he scored.

3rd. Bayliss's Shirepark Sir Francis Drake By Wilanorah.

PARTICOLOUR SPECIAL OPEN DOG (8,0).

1st./ DCC/BIS Torbett's Sh.Ch. Kerlinjis Taylor Made.

Came, saw & conquered victorious on the day. Dark blue roan stood out for outline, breed type, locomotion and soundness. Well moulded skull, good stop and muzzle. Dark, well set eye and gentle expression. Has masculinity, quality & substance. Excellent head carriage, neck, lay of shoulder & return of upper arm, legs & feet. Robust ribcage of correct depth & spring, powerful loin & couplings. Level topline, muscular, well turned hindquarters with correct set on & carriage of tail. Sound & free moving from every angle, maintaining his outline in profile and covering the ground with ease. Scored in muscular development of thighs.

2nd. Eisen's Multi Int. Ch. Alen Ashen Jonny Lee.

Handsome blue owning a typical head with clean skull, stop & chiselling below dark, expressive eye. Excellent head carriage, neck & well built forehand, legs & feet. Strong body & ribs, short back, compact loin & couplings. Fair hindquarters & set on of tail. Stylish, sound mover on which he scored in deportment.

3rd. Van Guyse-Apers' U Believe In Me Aster Bears.

PARTICOLOUR (OTHER THAN BLUE ROAN) SPECIAL OPEN DOG (4,0).

1st. Pearce-Gudger's Glowhill Silversmith For Pearkim.

Smart B/W Ticked in good form. Masculine, well moulded head, good eye set, colour & gentle expression. Clean neck & well laid shoulders. Quality & substance in limbs. Well made ribcage & loin. Fair hindquarters. Immaculate presentation. Scored in outline.

2nd. Bevis & Norie-Miller's Popocatepetl Tomfoolery.

O/W owning a typical head with a broad blaze. Melting, well set dark eye & expression. Well moulded skull, good stop, correct finish to muzzle. Good chiselling below eye. Well made neck & forehand construction. Would like a shade more length of foreleg. Good ribcage, body & loin. Fair hindquarters. Also immaculately presented. Scored in shape of backskull & tailset.

3rd. Smith's Pearkim Pokemon At Luanshya.

BLACK OR BLACK/TAN PUPPY DOG (2,0).

1st. Eisen's Kerriglow One Step Closer At Crankwoods.

10 months black. Typical skull, stop & muzzle. Well set eye & sweet expression. Excellent head carriage, neck & forehand. Good bone. Big ribs, strong loin & well turned hindquarters. Scored in movement driving off hocks with ease.

2nd. Ellison's Withiflor Touchstone.

9 months B/T. Exuberant & joyful character. Dark eye & mischievous expression. Masculine head, good neck & forehand angulation, ribcage still developing. Strong back. Fair hindquarters. Just needs time to settle into stride on the move.

BLACK OR BLACK/TAN NOVICE DOG (2,0).

1st. Share-Jones' Sharemead Turn Back Time.

Black 17 months scoring in substance throughout. Masculine head, dark eye, broad nose, good head carriage. Well made neck & forehand, legs & feet. Robust ribcage, body & ribs. Strong loin & hindquarters. Stylish, sound mover.

2nd. Young's Canyonn Black Caviar.

Black 15 months full of quality & refinement. Well chiselled head, sweet eye & expression, on which he scored. Neatly made withers, excellent ribcage, compact loin & coupling, well turned hindquarters.

BLACK OR BLACK/TAN GRADUATE DOG (5,2).

1st. Ellison's Spinoza of Merrily Avec Withiflor.

B/T owning a masculine head of balanced proportions, good skull, eye & expression. Pleasing head carriage, neck & lay of shoulder.

Would like a little more length in upper arm. Well boned limbs, strongly ribbed with good couplings and loin. Well turned hindquarters
Excellent coat & condition.

2nd. Anderson & Foster's Zakova Sundance Kyd At Sabaloo.

Smart black. Shapely skull, stop & muzzle. Kind eye & expression. Forehand a shade upright, well made body & ribs. Good loin & hindquarters. Happy mover.

3rd. Jenkins' Gino Della Sciaranera Of Bruxley.

BLACK OR BLACK & TAN OPEN DOG (4,1)

1st. Simonelli's Meden Agan Obama's Style.

Black owning a good outline, make, shape & type. Neatly made head, with good eye & expression. Excellent head carriage, neck & forehead construction. Good limbs. Well made body, ribs & turn of hindquarters. Well presented & handled.

2nd. Huc & Posuwajlo's John Lennon Vom Moorbachtal.

B/T. Masculine head. Would like a shade more stop. Good head carriage, neck, lay of shoulder & return of upper arm. Scores on substance in bone of limbs & feet. Well made ribcage & turn of hindquarters. Well presented & handled.

3rd. Pilkington & Ellis's Molkara Faustus At Brimbeck.

RED, GOLDEN, LIVER, OR LIVER/TAN NOVICE DOG (1,0).

1st. Jarvis's Galibar Goldeneye.

12 months red standing alone. Good muzzle & jaws, dark eye & pigmentation. Forehand a little upright, strong legs & feet. Well sprung ribcage for age, strong loin & couplings. Would like a little more angulation to croup. Happy nature.

RED, GOLDEN, LIVER OR LIVER/TAN GRADUATE DOG (3,1).

1st. Share-Jones' Sharemead Golden Spark.

Very promising typical 2 year old red. Stood out for make, shape & breed type. Well chiselled, balanced head with sweet eye & expression. Broad nose, strong jaws. Excellent head carriage, neck & lay of shoulders. Fine withers & good return of upper arm. Strong legs & feet. Well made ribcage, powerful loin & couplings. Muscular hindquarters with well set on tail. Sound & free in movement, on which he scored.

2nd. Pendlebury's Rockllocers Coconut Husk At Sandabys.

20 months. Good muzzle, broad nose, correct hazel eye colour, strong skull. Good head carriage, neck & forehead angulation. Would like a shade more length of foreleg & firmer topline. Sturdy ribcage & loin.

RED, GOLDEN LIVER OR LIVER/TAN OPEN DOG (3,0).

1st./BVIS Ellison's Sh.Ch. Withiflor Rolling Stone

10 year old red in good form. Balanced head with clean skull, stop & muzzle. Excellent chiselling below dark, expressive eye. Up to size for me but cannot be denied his other qualities of fine withers, excellent bone structure to limbs & feet, robust ribcage strong loin & driving hindquarters. Well presented & handled.

2nd. Boam's Heluin Take Applause.

Smart red. Well made skull & muzzle. Dark, expressive eye. Good head carriage, neck & forehead. Fair ribcage, couplings & turn of hindquarters. Well handled.

3rd. Wiggins' Sh.Ch. Snowgate Onyer Bike To Scapafeld.

ANY COLOUR VETERAN DOG (9,1).

1st. Pearce-Gudger's Sh.Ch. Cachel Prince Charming For Pearkim.

Neatly made 8 year old orange roan. Has quality, substance & refinement. Typical make & shape. Balanced, well chiselled head with dark eye & pigmentation. Correct head carriage, neck, shoulders & upper arm. Well made legs & feet, body, loin & hindquarters. Sound, in excellent condition. In the challenge for best veteran he just lost his outline at the end of a long day.

2nd. Czipott's Int.Ch. Lindridge Bolt From The Blue.

Impressive blue roan 9 year old. Up to size for me but has many outstanding qualities. Masculine, combining quality & substance throughout. Typical head, eye & expression, strongly built neck & forehead, excellent bone to limbs. Robust ribs, body & hindquarters. Sound & free on the move.

3rd. Cox's Sh.Ch. Gardenstone Pale Rider.

ANY COLOUR MINOR PUPPY DOG (6,0).

1st./BMPIS Darby's Classicway Call Time.

Very promising 8 months light blue. Masculine, well moulded muzzle, stop & skull. Good chiselling below eye. Dark, expressive eye.

Correct reach of neck, forechest & front. Excellent body & ribs for age. Short back, compact loin & couplings. Good stifles & hocks. Sound & free on the move.

2nd. Dewhurst's Glowhill Silver Arrow At Lapidary.

Well grown promising 9 months. Balanced head, kind eye & expression. Good neck & forehand. Ribcage still developing. Well turned hindquarters. Still carrying his puppy jacket. Cheerful character.

3rd. Beddow's Glowhill Stairway To Heaven.

ANY COLOUR PUPPY DOG (6,0).

1st./BOSPIS Amos-Jones' Dom Perignon Of La Vie Magnifique At Cassom

Very promising 10 months blue. Typical outline, make, shape & proportions. Broad nose, good eye shape, set & expression. Correct neck & forehand, shapely bone to legs & feet. Excellent body & ribs for age. Compact loin & close couplings.

Correct croup & set on of tail. Sound, free mover.

2nd. Duncan's Yodelmeister Vom Magiccircle In Bartonholm.

Another very promising 10 months B/W/T. Well grown with both quality & substance in bone structure throughout. Well moulded head, stop & skull. Gentle eye & expression. Correct head carriage, neck, shoulders & return of upper arm. Big ribs. Strong back & loin. Excellent turn of hindquarters & set on of tail. Well presented & handled. Pressed hard for top spot.

3rd. Cottbrune's Tzigane Of Merrily.

1st. McShane's Meggiemac Black Pearl.

Promising 13 months black. Typical head, well chiselled below eye. Kind, dark eye & sweet expression. Pleasing head carriage, neck & lay of shoulders, upper arm, strong legs & feet. Well sprung ribcage. Would like a shade closer coupling. Good turn of hinqarters. Excellent coat & condition. Well handled.

2nd. Handl & Eisen's Haradwater Mr. Fantastic.

3rd. Beever's Dandyjan Dark Defender.

ANY COLOUR YEARLING DOG (5,0).

1st. Wildman's Oktumi Major Player.

Smart 19 months dark blue with pleasing over all outline, make & shape. Good muzzle & jaws, fine leathers. Excellent head carriage, reach of neck, fine withers, well laid shoulders, upper arm, legs & feet. Scored well in body & ribs, turn of hindquarters. Excellent condition, presentation & handling.

2nd. Davidson's Annilann Mister Boo.

22 months blue. Typical, well balanced head with good skull, stop & finish of muzzle. Sweet, expressive eye. Would like a little more lay of shoulder. Excellent ribcage for spring & depth. Neatly made loin, couplings & hindquarters. Well presented & handled.

3rd. Duncan's Eastriding Blue Ambition.

ANY COLOUR MAIDEN DOG (6,0).

1st. Hackett's Lindridge Harbour Lights.

Very promising 12 months B/W/Tick. Excellent over all make, shape & breed type. Balanced, well moulded head. Gentle, soft expression. Good head carriage, neck & forehand construction, on which he scored, legs & feet. Correct spring of rib for age, compact loin. Well made hindquarters. Top notch youngster only needing time to mature.

2nd. Craig's Alisma Amarillio.

3rd. Hackett & Sheridan's Lindridge Star Attraction.

ANY COLOUR TYRO DOG (3,0).

1st. Darby's Allerts Don Viking At Classicway.

Attractive 13 months blue. Masculine head, quality skull & chiselling, broad nose. Good head carriage, well made forehand. Strong ribcage, compact loin, muscular hindquarters.

2nd. Hackett & Sheridan's Lindridge Star Attraction.

Promising 12 months light blue. Sweet head, good over all make & shape. Correct head carriage, neck & lay of shoulder, and upper arm. Well boned limbs. Ribcage still developing. Just needs time to mature. Moved well.

3rd. Gilmour's Chavez Silver Cloud.

ANY COLOUR SPECIAL BEGINNERS DOG (10,1).

1st. Wright's La Scales Berlin With Chazbaz.

Very smart black in peak form. Masculine head with good skull, muzzle tight dark eye & merry expression. Clean neck & shoulders, good withers, & return of upper arm. Well boned limbs & feet. Big ribs, strong body & muscular hindquarters. Stood out for type & balance in this class.

2nd. Robinson's Wilmerella Perfect Storm.

Blue with good general outline. Masculine head, gentle expression. Good nose & jaws. Pleasing head carriage, neck & lay of shoulder. Big ribs, strong loin, fair hindquarters. Cheerful character. Well handled.

3rd. Furzer's Durham Blue.

ANY COLOUR POST GRADUATE DOG (3,1).

1st. Kitchen's Annilann Bhama Mama.

Blue with overall good make & shape. Well moulded head, sweet eye & expression. Scored in topline. Would like a little more angulation to forehand. Well made ribcage & loin. Moved well keeping his outline in profile.

2nd. Pendlebury's Rocklocers Coconut Husk At Sandabys. (Repeat).

ANY COLOUR MINOR LIMIT DOG (8,1).

1st. Saunders' Carmelfair Corocenzo At Oxfordogs.

Very typical blue owning both quality & substance. Masculine, well balanced head with dark eye. Good head carriage, neck & lay of shoulder. Big ribs, short back, powerful loin & well made hindquarters, on which he scored. Excellent coat & condition. Well handled.

2nd. Scotland's Lynwater Anything Goes.

Orange roan with well moulded skull & chiselling under eyes. Dark pigmentation. Pleasing head carriage, neck, forehand, legs & feet. Well made ribcage, short coupled. Good loin & hindquarters. Sound, free mover.

3rd. Hutson's Stobyhill After The Storm.

ANY COLOUR LIMIT DOG (8,0).

1st. Cottebrune's Saint Exupery Of Merrily.

Red with excellent outline, make, shape & type. Has masculinity, quality & substance. Well made head, good chiselling & proportions. Tight eye, mischievous expression & fine leathers. Scored in neck, forehand angulation, legs & feet. Correct ribcage for spring & depth. Powerful loin & couplings. Muscular hindquarters with strong stifles & hocks. Sound & free locomotion. Well presented.

2nd. Roberts & Smith's Rayol Look Hu's Talking.

Blue with a lot of class & style. Balanced head with good muzzle, stop & skull. Well chiselled below eye. Typical, sweet expression. Excellent head carriage. Strongly constructed forehand, big ribcage, well knit body & couplings.

Short coupled, powerful loin croup. Well turned hindquarters & set on of tail. Sound, free mover who always commanded attention.

ANY COLOUR OPEN DOG (8,0).

1st./RDCC/RBIS Williams' Sh.Ch. Wilmerella Outlander.

Refined blue having quality, substance & breed type in abundance. Balanced, well moulded head with correct proportions, stop and chiselling. Dark, gentle eye & expression. Correct head carriage, clean neck & shoulders, good withers & return of upper arm. Excellent legs & feet. Robust ribcage, strong loin & well knit couplings. Correct croup, turn of hindquarters & set on of tail. Sound & free in movement keeping his outline in profile. Beautifully presented & skilfully handled.

2nd. Hackett's Lindridge Front Runner.

Light orange roan owning a masculine, balanced head with well finished muzzle, stop & skull. Good neck, shoulders strong legs & feet. Big, roomy ribcage, strong back & loin. Well turned hindquarters. Moved soundly once into stride.

3rd. Birkenshaw's Sh.Ch. Gilcar Midnight Dream.
